Responsibilities as a Preschool Classroom Teacher:

- Create positive, well-organized and orderly learning environment where children feel welcome and comfortable.
- Promote interaction and learning among peers.
- Foster positive relationships with students, parents, fellow teachers, non-teaching personnel, and administration through excellent communication.
- Effectively lead classroom aides and assistants in fulfilling the duties of the classroom.
- Gather student data for ongoing progress monitoring.
- Follow Ohio Department of Education Early Learning Standards and appropriate curriculum as provided.
- Participate in, contribute to and update IEPs as needed.

Requirements:

- Bachelor's Degree in Deaf Education or Special Education.
- Master's Degree in Deaf Education or Special Education preferred.
- Currently hold or eligibility to obtain Ohio Department of Education Teaching License.
- Strong commitment to listening and spoken language methodology.
- Strong planning and organizational skills.
- Excellent oral and written communication skills.
- Ability to work effectively as a member of a collaborative team.
